EDGEWOOD ANIMAL CLINIC BOARDING POLICY

All animals must be current on all required vaccinations and have a negative parasite exam within one year. All cats must have been tested once for Feline Leukemia/FIV. Documentation must be present.

- All animals must be free of external parasites (fleas and ticks). If parasites are present, the pet will be treated with internal and external prevention and charged accordingly.
- Please bring any medications or specific diet that your pet requires during their stay with us. We will feed Hills Sensitive Diet if none is provided.
- We use our own bedding material for sanitation and safety reasons. Therefore we cannot accept any personal bedding with pet's stay.
- **Please leave an emergency contact phone number below. If an emergency occurs and the owner cannot be contacted, measures necessary to treat the animal will be taken and charged accordingly.**
- Charges are based on the day of arrival, until the day of discharge. Pet must be discharged **before 2pm.** to avoid another day's charge. Pets discharged on Sunday are for owner's convenience and a full day's charge is incurred for that day.
- This boarding policy is designed for the health, safety and comfort of you pet.
